(Morpeth, Bolam, Wallington, Colwell, Ingoe, Stamfordham, West Denton)

The run starts as usual at Seaton Burn services and finishes at West Denton Fire Station, where fish and chips will be ordered in. Numbers will be taken at the start of the run and phoned through.

Please be at the start at 6:45pm for the ride briefing, the ride to start promptly at 7pm. The ride will use the drop-off system, with (depending on numbers) two groups.

DIRECTIONS FROM SEATON BURN SERVICES

Follow old A1 north, filter onto A1. Exit A197 towards Morpeth. NOT MARKED.

Enter 30mph limit, after 0.4 miles turn left on B6524 signposted Belsay.

After 5 miles turn right in Whalton, signposted Meldon and Bolam.

After 4 miles turn left at T junction, signposted Newcastle and Belsay.

After 0.4 miles, turn right at T junction, signposted Scots Gap, Cambo and Rothbury.

After 2.8 miles turn left on unmarked road, signposted Wallington and Hexham.

After 1.3 miles, turn left on B6342 signposted Newcastle, Hexham and Belsay.

At A696 turn right and immediately left. Continue on B6342.

50 metres before reaching A68, turn sharp left on unmarked road signposted Matfen and Ryal.

After 4.7 miles (0.5 miles after hamlet of Ryal) turn left, signposted Belsay and Ingoe.

After 1.6 miles turn right at T junction, signposted Wallridge and Belsay.

After 2 miles straight on at crossroads (crossing major road).

After 1 mile turn right on B6309.

In Stamfordham, turn left at T junction signposted Ponteland and Newcastle.

After 0.65 miles turn right, signposted Wylam and Newcastle.

After 7.6 miles turn right at traffic lights onto Hillhead Road.

After 0.63 miles turn left at traffic lights, then right into Fire Station.
